

## NOTICE OF REVIEW OF POLLING DISTRICTS, POLLING PLACES AND POLLING STATIONS

1. Notice is hereby given that Burnley Borough Council is conducting a review of the polling districts, polling places and polling stations that fall within the Borough of Burnley.
2. The Returning Officer for the Parliamentary Constituency of Burnley will make comment on the proposals and those representations will be published on the Council's website and notice boards in accordance with the timetable set out below.
3. Electors within the Parliamentary Constituency of Burnley may make a representation.
4. The Council would welcome the views of all residents, particularly disabled residents, or any person or body with expertise in access for persons with any type of disability, on the proposals, and Returning Officer's representation, or any other related matters.
5. Persons or bodies making representations should, if possible, give alternative places that may be used as polling places.
