

## **New Street Trader Consent Advice (June 2022)**

In order to apply for a Street Trading Consent you are required to submit the following documents:

- A completed application form
- Basic DBS Certificate not more than 28 days old
- Current gas and electrical safety certificates

You should submit your application to by email to [licensing@burnley.gov.uk](mailto:licensing@burnley.gov.uk)

Further details can be obtained from Town Centre Management in respect of trading in the Town Centre and the Parks Department in respect of trading in any park in the Borough by telephoning 01282 425011.

Please note that if the consent relates to a van or trailer and that is placed at or near a highway then we expect that the relevant Highways Authority will have been contacted. When making contact, please stress the request is for a certificate for a mobile vehicle.

Likewise for a gas safety certificate:

[Gas Safe Register - The Official List of Gas Safe Registered Businesses - Gas Safe Register has replaced CORGI registration. Don't cut corners, only use a Gas Safe registered engineer.](#) Input a postcode, click commercial & then change fuel to **LPG**
