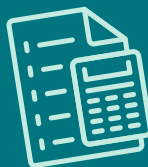

The Burnley Community grocery is open for the people of Burnley helping to keep families fed and give support. It is run in partnership by The Message Trust and the Life Church. The annual membership fee is £5 and each shop just £4 and individuals can shop up to 3 times per week.

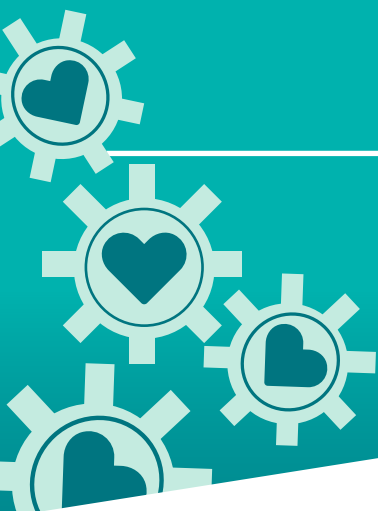

Over two weeks **710 children, from 30 different schools** were helped in getting free school uniform. **Boys 324 | Girls 386**

CHRISTMAS APPEAL

1032 children, aged 0-16 years received a Christmas parcel.

545 families referred in with 527 boys and 505 girls.

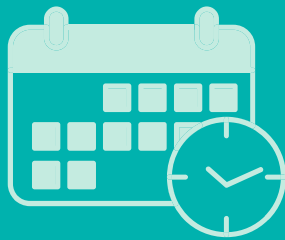

**WINTER WARM PACKS:
67 GIVEN OUT SINCE OCTOBER**

For people struggling with heating. In the pack there is a gilet, blanket, gloves, hat, mug, hot water bottle and some cup a soups. Referrals have come from several different agencies such as Age UK, Social Services, INT, BPRCVS and LCC Wellbeing.

PLUS: 31 properties provided with Led light bulbs between October and November.
