

The Burnley (32 Hurtley Street Burnley) Compulsory Purchase Order 2024

NOTICE is hereby given that the Burnley Borough Council has made The Burnley (32 Hurtley Street Burnley) Compulsory Purchase Order 2024 under section 17 of the Housing Act 1985. It is about to submit this order to the Secretary of State for Housing, Communities & Local Government for confirmation, and if confirmed, the order will authorise Burnley Borough Council to purchase compulsorily the land described below for the purpose of bringing the property erected on the land back into residential use.

A copy of the order and the accompanying map may be seen at all reasonable hours at the Offices of Burnley Borough Council, Town Hall, Manchester Road, Burnley, BB11 9SA and are available for view on the Council's website at www.burnley.gov.uk.

Any objection to the order must be made in writing to the Secretary of State for Housing, Communities & Local Government, PCU, 23 Stephenson Street, Birmingham, B2 4BH before 2 December 2024 and should state the title of the order and the grounds of objection and the objector's address and interests in the land.

The dwellinghouse situate at Burnley, Lancashire together with the appurtenances thereto, known as 32 Hurtley Street Burnley BB10 1BY.
