Regarding the above application submitted by Riley Mixed Concrete:-

My objections to the above are:-

The dust pollution created by the vehicles carrying ready mixed concrete from the premises at Dunnockshaw Farm to the main Burnley road, which is impacting on our health and welfare, plus our property being covered in cement dust as well as garden and vehicles parked at our property. Also the amount of aggregate being delivered to the cement factory plus other materials.

The amount of traffic these vehicles are creating is causing problems with the already existing traffic in and out of the slaughterhouse at Dunnockshaw farm which happens on a daily basis thus creating more noise at unsociable hours.

Access and exit to this company is via one small road, the amount of vibration from these vehicles entering and exiting is having an impact on the structure of our property, ie not being able to open windows due to airborne cement dust which is known to be a Carcinogenic also sleeping issues and health issues in general.

Over the last few years the traffic in and out of Dunnockshaw farm has increased multiple times, and this addition will again increase the traffic flow more to an unbearable level for the local residents.

This company has been in operation for at least six months or more and complaints have been submitted previously to Burnley Environmental Health with regards to the above issues.

We strongly urge the council to reject this application on the grounds of public health, and the well-being of the Dunnockshaw residents. Please record this letter as a formal objection on the public register and we would appreciate confirmation that this letter has been received and registered.
