**NOTICE OF INTENTION TO EXTEND THE BURNLEY BOROUGH COUNCIL DOG CONTROL PUBLIC
SPACES PROTECTION ORDER**

1. Notice is hereby given that Burnley Borough Council ("the Council") intends to extend the above Public Spaces Protection Order under Section 60 of the Anti-Social behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014 ("the Act") for a period of three years from 16th January 2026
2. The Council is satisfied on reasonable grounds that doing so is necessary to prevent:
 - a. Occurrence or recurrence of activities identified in the order and/or
 - b. An increase in the frequency or seriousness of those activities

after the expiry of the existing order on 9th January 2026

3. The proposed Order relates to the control of dogs in public spaces as specified on the Order and Order Schedule. This Order applies at all times to the land specified in the Schedule
4. The proposed Order and Plan are available for inspection on the Councils website at <https://burnley.gov.uk/parks-green-spaces/dog-control-orders> and also at the Reception, Town Hall, Manchester Road, Burnley
5. Any challenge to the validity of the Order may be made by an Interested Party, should comply with Section 66 Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014 and be sent to Streetscene@burnley.gov.uk or in writing to Dog Control PSPO, Streetscene, Town Hall, Manchester Road, Burnley BB11 9SA
