NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Burnley Borough Council on the 18th June, 1975 designated part of Padiham as a Conservation Area. A copy of the plan showing the area designated is available for inspection during normal office hours at Padiham Town Hall, the Planning and Estates Office, 6 Elizabeth Street, Burnley and at my Department in the Town Hall, Burnley. A Schedule of the properties within the area is set out at the foot of this Notice.

The effect of designation is that

1. ANY PERSON WISHING TO DEMOLISH ANY BUILDING OR TO ALTER OR TO EXTEND ANY BUILDING WITHIN THE CONSERVATION AREA; and
2. ANYONE INTENDING TO LOP, TOP, REMOVE, UPROOT OR DESTROY ANY TREE GROWING IN THE CONSERVATION AREA

MUST INFORM THE COUNCIL OF HIS INTENTION AND OBTAIN PERMISSION TO EXECUTE THE APPROPRIATE WORKS.

Advice on the need for planning consent and on Conservation Area matters generally may be obtained from the Planning and Estates Office.
